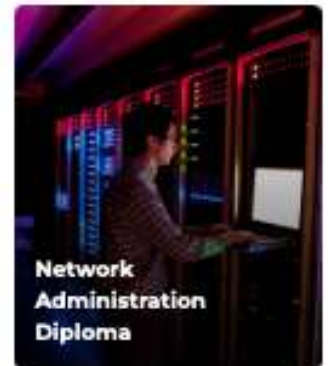

IBT College offers the only Augmented Reality and Virtual Reality platform for private career college students in Canada.

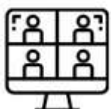
Our platform will allow you to interact with objects, places, and models as an experiential textbook. Through Augmented and Virtual Reality you learn through showing rather than telling.

IBT College is pleased to announce that it has been awarded an Ontario Micro-credentials Community Impact Award from the Ministry of Colleges and Universities (MCU) together with the Ministry of Labour, Training and Skills Development (MLTSD)

The Micro-credentials will provide online training and virtual reality simulations in dementia care, palliative care, safety and mobility, assisting with feeding, and measuring height, weight and vital signs.

Through the Community Impact Award, IBT College will develop nine additional Micro-credentials. These additional modules will complete the theoretical portion of the Personal Support Worker diploma.

Micro-credentials bring flexibility and improved responsiveness to learner/job seeker and employer needs.

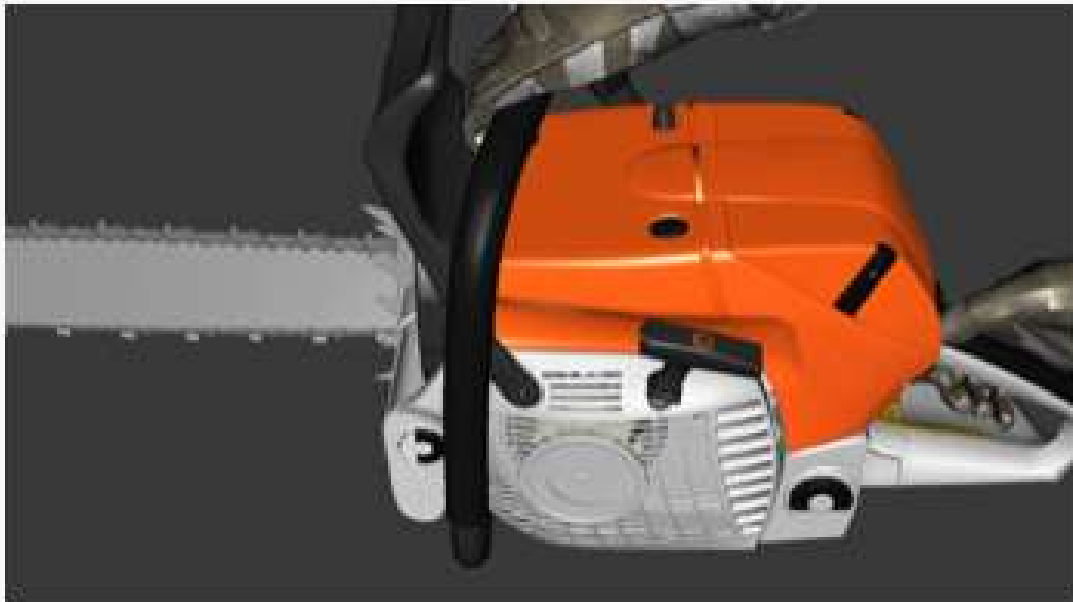
OPPORTUNITIES IN TRADES & MANUFACTURING

3D immersive training platform for ExxonMobil that improves the way field workers and panel operators train together.



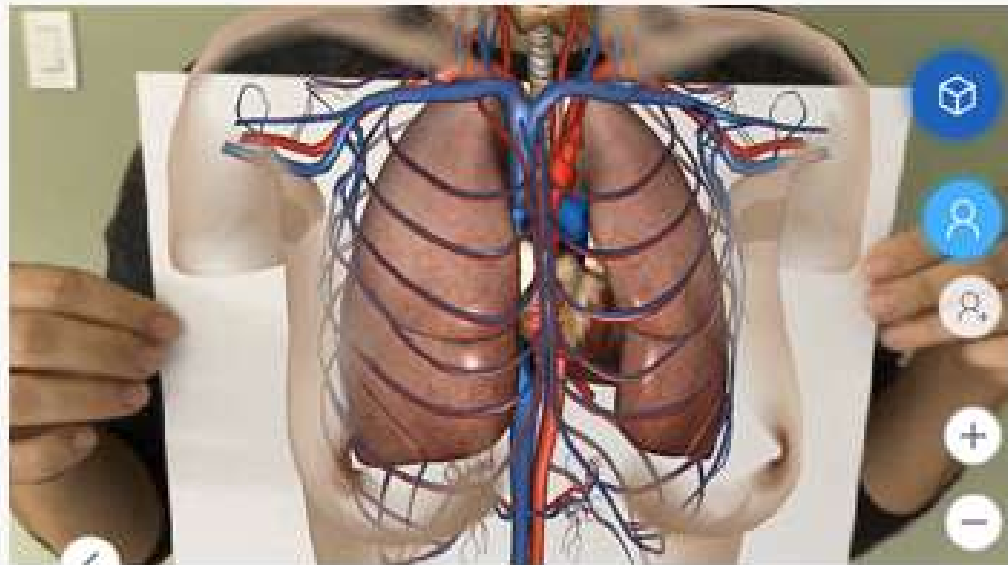
VR FORESTRY SERVICES TRAINING

Interactive 3D forestry services training application about how to properly use a chainsaw.



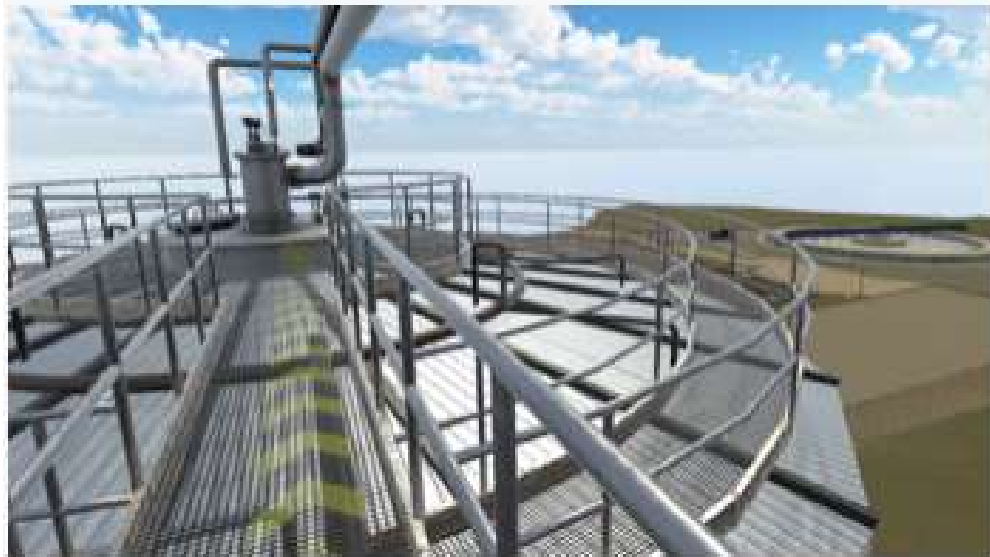
VIRTUAL DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

Automation will likely affect over half of Canadian jobs in the next decade, but being human could be the very thing that helps Canadians stay employed.

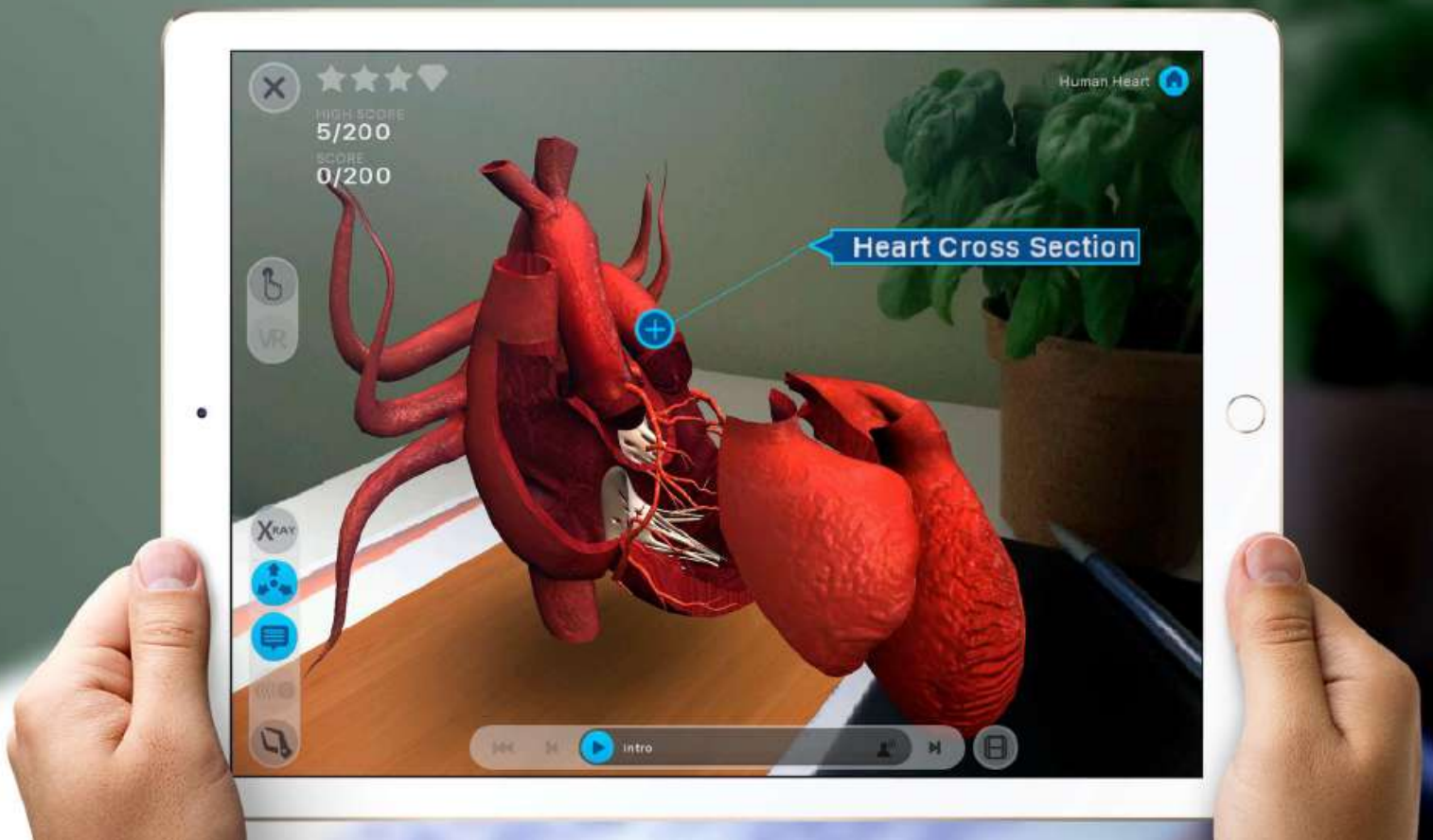
While employers and educational institutions may not be prepared for these changes at the moment, Mullin states that schools and workplaces have an opportunity to work together to ensure students are prepared.
